Relax, Recharge, and Renew



The months of summer have traditionally been the time to plan and enjoy vacations. The kids are out of school and it is time to spend some time at the beach, at the cabin, or whatever it is that gives you and your family a chance to relax, recharge, and renew. Vacations are important. Look at some of the benefits of "time away":

* Vacations Can Keep Us Healthy: Taking regular time off to 'recharge your batteries', thereby keeping stress levels lower, can keep you healthier.

* Vacations Promote Overall Wellbeing: One study found that three days after vacation, subjects' physical complaints, their quality of sleep and mood had improved as compared to before vacation. These gains were still present five weeks later, especially in those who had more personal time and overall satisfaction during their vacations.

* Vacations Can Strengthen Bonds: Spending time enjoying life with loved ones can keep relationships strong, helping you enjoy the good times more and helping you through the stress of the hard times.

* Vacations Relieve Stress in Lasting Ways: It should come as no surprise that vacations that include plenty of free time bring stress relief, but research shows that a good vacation can lead to the experience of fewer stressful days at least five weeks later! That means that vacations are the gift to yourself that keep on giving.

The bottom line is that taking a good amount of time away from the stresses of daily life can give us the break we need so that we can return to our lives refreshed and better equipped to handle whatever comes.

I want to encourage you to include a specific activity as part of your vacation this year. This is an activity you can do as an individual, as a couple or as a family. Begin each day of your vacation with a devotional. You do not need to read a book of the Bible every morning (although you may choose to do so), but find a devotional that has a biblical base and is enjoyable to read and share. Guideposts, The Upper Room, and Our Daily Bread are a few that I enjoy. Look for one that is suited to you and your life situation.

When you begin each day in devotion, you will find your vacation not only renewing your body and mind but recharging your spiritual self as well. Take Jesus on vacation with you! You know that He is present always so start each day in conversation with Him.
